Smith told SA Langston that the Department of Children and Families (DCF) had been contacted [REDACTED]

Captain Smith said that Arroyo was a long term employee of KWPD and had many friends and acquaintances within the department. Smith requested FDLE investigate.

In furtherance of the investigation into allegations of sexual battery, involving suspect Henry Arroyo, Jr. the following occurred.

On Thursday, December 19, 2013 Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Special Agent (SA) Mike Langston met with Key West Police Department (KWPD) Detective Sergeant Bernardo Barrios and KWPD Detective Scott Standerwick at the Key West Police Department.

Sergeant Barrios told SA Langston that he received a fascimilie complaint of abuse from [REDACTED] of the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) in the morning of December 17, 2013. Barrios assigned Detective Scott Standerwick to assist DCF and investigate.

Detective Standerwick said that he responded to the victim's school, [REDACTED] in Key West, Florida, where he met with [REDACTED]. Detective Standerwick and [REDACTED] interviewed Dean Megan Faust, at approximately 1300 hours. Detective Standerwick recorded the interview. Dean Faust told Detective Standerwick that a week previously the school had a guest speaker that addressed the students about self-esteem, coping with peers, etc. which may have prompted the complaint. Dean Faust said the victim, [REDACTED], came to her in the morning hours of December 17, 2013 and reported abuse from [REDACTED] Henry Arroyo, Jr. which Dean Faust then reported to DCF.

Detective Standerwick said that an interview with the victim was conducted on December 17, 2013 at approximately 1320 hours. Detective Standerwick recorded the interview. Present at the interview were [REDACTED], Detective Standerwick and the victim. Detective Standerwick said he was in plain clothes with no police insignia and was introduced to the victim by [REDACTED] as an investigator. Detective Standerwick said he asked no questions during the interview conducted by [REDACTED]. Detective Standerwick said the victim was very soft spoken, however provided information about sexual abuse she alleged was committed by subject Arroyo.

At approximately 1345 hours Detective Standerwick and Investigator [REDACTED] interviewed the juvenile brother of the victim, [REDACTED]. Detective Standerwick recorded the interview. Detective Standerwick said [REDACTED] behaved normally and provided no additional

Detective Sergeant Barrios told SA Langston that he conducted an interview with Arroyo at approximately 1600 hours on December 17, 2013 at the Key West Police Station. Detective Sergeant Barrios said he [REDACTED] and confronted Arroyo with the allegations from the victim. Detective Sergeant Barrios said Arroyo became visibly upset, did not claim innocence or guilt and told Barrios that he wanted to remain silent. Detective Sergeant Barrios said Officer Arroyo was subsequently placed on administrative leave by KWPD administration.

SA Langston requested, and was provided written statements from Detective Sergeant Barrios and Detective Standerwick describing their involvement to date in the case. SA Langston requested and was provided a copy of subject officer Arroyo's KWPD personnel and disciplinary file.

SA Langston secured the DCF facsimile as electronic related item number one (1) with this case.

SA Langston secured Detective Standerwick's written statement as related item number two (2) with this case.

SA Langston secured Detective Sergeant Barrios' written statement as related item number three (3) with this case.

In furtherance of the investigation into allegations of sexual battery, involving suspect Henry Arroyo, Jr. the following occurred.

On Monday, January 27, 2014 Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Special Agent (SA) Mike Langston conducted a sworn, taped interview, of Dean Megan Faust at the [REDACTED] in Key West, Florida. Dean Faust was the initial reporter of abuse concerning victim [REDACTED], and is the Behavior Specialist, and Dean of Students, at the [REDACTED]. Present at the interview was State Attorney's Office Chief Investigator Christopher Weber.

Dean Faust provided the following information during the interview: Dean Faust was hired by [REDACTED] in July of 2012. Dean Faust has known victim [REDACTED] since August of 2012 when [REDACTED] was in 7th grade and attending the school. Dean Faust said [REDACTED] also attends [REDACTED] School and is in the 3rd grade.

Dean Faust said part of her duties is handling discipline and counseling issues with the students. Dean Faust described [REDACTED] as an average student with no disciplinary issues. Dean Faust recalled having a meeting with [REDACTED] in March of 2013 concerning grades. Dean Faust said the meeting was productive and resulted in elevation of [REDACTED] grades.

Dean Faust said [REDACTED] Henry Arroyo, a police officer with the Key West Police Department (KWPD). Dean Faust said Henry Arroyo and [REDACTED] have individually picked up [REDACTED] from the school during this school year (2013). Dean Faust said Henry Arroyo was generally dressed in his KWPD uniform. Dean Faust said she never witnessed [REDACTED], pick up the children from school.

Dean Faust said on December 17, 2013 [REDACTED] was attending a Physical Education (PE) class in school and requested to speak with Dean Faust. Dean Faust took [REDACTED] to a private room where [REDACTED] became emotional and told Dean Faust that she "had information that she wanted to tell, but was afraid to tell". [REDACTED] then told Dean Faust that [REDACTED] (Henry Arroyo) on multiple occasions in the past, had forced her [REDACTED] to place her hand on his (Arroyo's) penis.

Dean Faust said [REDACTED] was emotionally upset and reluctant to provide details of the incidents. Dean Faust said [REDACTED] was afraid to give details because she did not want to damage her mother's [REDACTED] relationship with [REDACTED] (Arroyo). Dean Faust asked [REDACTED] if anything recently had occurred, [REDACTED] replied that nothing recent had happened.

Dean Faust asked [REDACTED] if she reported the incidents to her mother [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said she did report the incidents "a couple of times" to her mother and her mother told her to "forget about it". Dean Faust said [REDACTED] was very concerned for her mother's ([REDACTED]) well being and did not want to cause problems in her mother's relationship [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and feared ruining [REDACTED].

Dean Faust said on December 4, 2013 the school had a guest speaker, Elisa Levy. Levy's topic was "body image", and was meant to educate the students on what normal people look like and to comfort the students on their bodies. Dean Faust said [REDACTED] attended this class, however was unsure if this pre-empted [REDACTED]' reporting of the incidents.

Dean Faust said she immediately reported the alleged abuse to the abuse hotline (1-800-96-ABUSE) and the school's principal, Elisa Jannes. Dean Faust said the Department of Children and Families (DCF) came to the school with a KWPD officer and interviewed her, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. Dean Faust said [REDACTED] appeared to be "ok" after the incident, however was withdrawn from school around January 9, 2014 at the request of [REDACTED]' mother [REDACTED]. Dean Faust was told [REDACTED] was going to live in Tampa, Florida.

During the interview SA Langston stopped the recording for a break to allow Dean Faust to gather records indicating the dates of incidents. This resulted in two recording sessions.

SA Langston secured the audio (CD) containing two recordings of the interview as related item number 17 with this case.

On Thursday, January 30, 2014 Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Special Agent (SA) Mike Langston conducted a sworn, taped interview, of [REDACTED] at the State Attorney's Office in Key West, Florida. [REDACTED] the biological father of victim [REDACTED] Present at the interview was State Attorney's Office Chief Investigator Christopher Weber.

[REDACTED] provided the following information: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were married in 1998. Their children [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were born respectfully on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. They lived together as a family unit until 2008 when they separated and subsequently divorced in 2009. During that period they lived in the family home located at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] reported an amicable divorce with "hurt feelings, but never ugly". [REDACTED] said that there was no custody issues and that they worked together to provide a stable base for the children. [REDACTED] described his relationship with his children as open and honest. [REDACTED] said that when he "came out" (admitting to being a homosexual) he told his children immediately to avoid any rumors they may hear. He believes that his children are open and honest with him to this day.

[REDACTED] said immediately following the divorce, the children lived with him until [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The children moved into that home which became the primary home for the children in late 2009 to early 2010. [REDACTED] said that the relationship between him and [REDACTED] remains amicable.

[REDACTED] said there were no significant changes to the custody of the children, as they did whatever was best for the children. [REDACTED] described the apartment as a two-bedroom one-bath apartment. [REDACTED] said that the two children shared a bedroom with individual twin beds set on opposite walls. [REDACTED] said the children's bedroom was approximately 10'x12'and that the entire apartment may have encompassed 700 square feet. [REDACTED] visited this apartment often when picking up the children, and was familiar with its floor plan.

██████████ said that sometime in 2011 Henry Arroyo, ██████████ was confident of the year because he recalled it was the summer before ██████████ entrance into the 6<sup>th</sup> grade. They lived in the Tampa area at the ██████████, which is located at ██████████. ██████████ said that the living conditions were similar in that the children shared a common bedroom, however the house itself was much bigger.

██████████ said around December 2011, ██████████, Henry Arroyo ██████████ moved back to the Florida Keys from the Tampa area. The children stayed with ██████████ and attended ██████████ until the end of the school year, which would have been June 2012. ██████████ said that ██████████ and Henry Arroyo moved into Henry's relatives house while they waiting for their home to be ready. This is the current reported residence for Henry Arroyo, which is located at ██████████. Sometime after June 2012, ██████████ Henry Arroyo.

██████████ provided the following information in relation to the first incident:

██████████ said that sometime in March/April 2013, he received a call from ██████████. ██████████ described ██████████ as distraught and upset. ██████████ said that ██████████ is never upset and "rarely lets it out". ██████████ did not tell him why she was upset but she said, "I need to talk to you." ██████████ was visiting ██████████ Sonny Napoles when he received the call. ██████████ met ██████████ in the parking of the Adult Superstore on Rockland Key. Prior to the meeting, ██████████ dropped both children at ██████████ family home on ██████████

██████████ said when they met, ██████████ told him that ██████████ said she (██████████) had seen Henry's penis. ██████████ told ██████████ that "██████████ hand ended up on Henry's penis." ██████████ said that ██████████ did not elaborate, offered no other information, and did not speak about time, place or frequency. ██████████ feeling was that ██████████ was speaking in the past tense and the incident or incidents occurred in the past. When asked why he felt that way, ██████████ said it was just a feeling.

██████████ said that he left his car in the parking lot and rode with ██████████ in her car to his house to speak with ██████████. ██████████ said his memory of the event is fuzzy and the discussion involved all of them, and then just him and ██████████ and then the three of them again. ██████████ did tell her father at one point that "maybe Henry made a mistake". ██████████ did not elaborate on that statement. ██████████ said the discussion was emotionally charged and ██████████ had shut down offering only head-shaking answers to specific questions.

According to ██████████ ██████████ never used the word penis and never used the word erect. ██████████ did gesture in the affirmative to the question of, "was his penis erect?" She gestured in the negative to, "did he ever ejaculate?".

██████████ said his daughter was in a posture where her legs were pulled up to her chest and she was holding a pillow up to her chin and throat area only showing her eyes and the nose area of her face. The discussion between ██████████ ██████████ and ██████████ stopped shortly

thereafter. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] had "shut down" emotionally and he never had a discussion with her about this again.

[REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] told him after the incident that Arroyo was distraught and had been considering suicide. This was information he had received from [REDACTED] and he was not aware of any overt acts that would confirm these statements. The bathroom was at the end of a hallway and just past the children's room. █████ said she and Arroyo slept in a queen size bed. █████ until May of 2011 and did not have any live-in guests during █████
