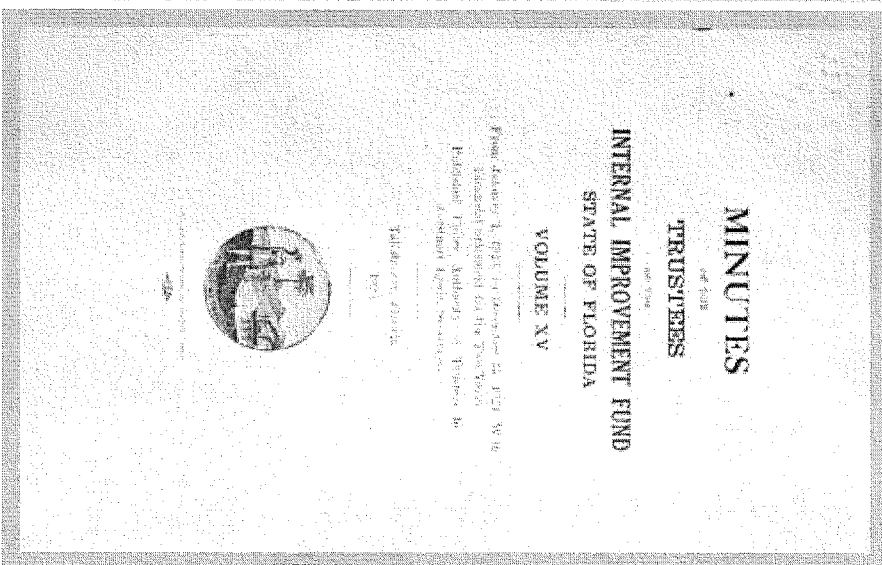

Tallahassee, Florida, June 11, 1924.

The Trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund met on this date in the office of the Governor in the Capitol.

Present:

Cary A. Hardee, Governor.
Ernest Amos, Comptroller.
J. C. Luning, Treasurer.
Rivers Buford, Attorney General.
Nathan Mayo, Commissioner of Agriculture.

The Trustees further considered the sale of Islands in Harbor of Key West, Monroe County, offered for sale May 20, 1924, and after discussion it was decided to withdraw the island from sale and reject all bids. The Secretary was instructed to return checks of bidders and advise them of the action of the Trustees.

Mr. John C. Sherman, representing Brown Company, of Portland, Maine, appeared before the Trustees with reference to exchanging lands owned by them for other lands of the Trustees. Whereupon, it was agreed to exchange Sections 23, 27 and 35, Township 45 South, Range 38 East, owned by Brown Company, for Sections 2, 4, 10, 12 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 45 South, Range 39 East, owned by the Trustees.

Lands advertised for sale in Dade, Okeechobee and Palm Beach Counties, title which had vested in the Trustees, were reconsidered and it was decided that where former owners of said land had produced evidence of ownership and applied for same prior to May 20, 1924, that their bids be accepted and deeds issued.
