Complaint regarding SRO David Hall

In response to a recent news article concerning weapons at Horace O' Bryant School, I met with Captain Torres. During the course of that conversation, we contacted Officer Hall and asked him to come to the station to discuss the incidents referenced in the article. As the three of us met, Captain Torres contacted Sgt. Matt Haley because he had additional information.

During this meeting we discussed the several incidents to include the incidents outlined below.

Incident #1

In October of 2017, Officer David Hall received information while assigned to Horace O' Bryant School as the School Resource Officer about a Snapchat picture that depicted a student from HOB holding a gun. Officer Hall met with the student and his parents about the Snapchat picture. According to Officer Hall the parents took the matter seriously. The father believed his son probably posed with the gun recently because he had the gun out cleaning it. The parents told Officer Hall they would make sure the gun and all weapons in their possession would be secured and stored in a safe place so the student did not have access to it or any weapons. No police report was written.

Incident #2

Shortly after this incident it was brought to Officer Hall's attention that the Snapchat picture from Incident #1 was circulating around again. This time there was a caption overlaid on top of the original picture. The caption said "(student's name) gonna bust a cap in yah head". Officer Hall contacted the father who was adamant the student's cell phone had been taken away and the student had no access to the internet and could not have added the overlaid caption. No police report was written.

Incident #3

There was an incident involving a different student who brought a small orange plastic cap gun to school. The student displayed the cap gun in the courtyard of the school. School officials and Officer

Hall were notified. The student was suspended 5 days and expelled from HOB and transferred to the alternative program in the rear of KWHS. Officer Hall stated that he wrote a police report and issued a Juvenile Civil Citation.

Incident #4

On January 17, 2018 School Personnel in the after-school program reported to School Administration that the student involved in Incident #1 & 2 may have brought a gun onto the campus during an after-hours basketball game on Tuesday, January 16. On Thursday, January 18 Officer Hall and AP Mr. Vinson interviewed the student who had spoken to the after-school personnel. Officer Hall stated to us that the student changed his story several times and by the end of the interview the student was not even sure if he saw a gun, but the student said there was a second student there who saw the gun. That second student was interviewed however the second student acted as if he had no idea of what took place and denied seeing a gun at all. Regardless School Administration searched the student in question, his locker, and backpack in the presence of Officer Hall. School Administration reviewed school video and found no evidence to support the allegation according to Officer Hall. Principal Ms. McPherson and AP Mr. Vinson had both attended the basketball game and at no time were they approach about the possibility of a gun being on campus. No police report was written.

Since this initial discussion took place, Officer Hall has stated adamantly to the FBI and the State Attorney's Office, Captain Torres and me (Lt. Kathleen Ream) that he wrote a police report and a juvenile civil citation on Incident #3 as recently as February 20th. Between the initial conversation and February 20 Officer Hall provide several different accounts to Captain Torres and I regarding Incident #2. During one conversation Officer Hall stated he had met with the student in Incident #2 and the boy, a friend of his, that had overlaid the image. Officer Hall also stated he did not know who overlaid the caption.

On February 20, I, Lt. Kathleen Ream, went to KWPD Records to get a copy of the report and juvenile civil citation from Incident #3. However, neither a police report nor a juvenile civil citation was written on incident #3 or any of the above listed incidents.

Based on Officer Hall's statements to Captain Torres and I (Lt. Kathleen Ream), the Chief made and reported Officer Hall's untruthful accounts to the media, Department Facebook's page, the Monroe County School District, and the State Attorney's Office.
